

2027 Dwyer Williams Cherkoss Attorneys, P.C. Law School Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the DWC Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a U.S. citizen or otherwise authorized to work in the United States
- Accepted and attending their first year of law school in the Fall of 2027
- Undergraduate cumulative minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must have received a bachelor's degree from an accredited undergraduate college in the United States

REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for the DWC Scholarship, applicants must submit the following by **June 30, 2027**:

- A completed Scholarship Application Form
- One to three (1–3) page typed essay. The subject is open-ended and entirely up to the applicant. For example, applicants may choose to focus on personal or family history, achievements, overcoming adversity, volunteerism, goals as a future lawyer, or any other compelling topic.
- A complete copy of undergraduate college transcripts. These may be **official or unofficial**. If submitted via services like **Parchment**, please note that these links are time-sensitive and may expire before being accessed, so ensure sufficient time is given.
- An **acceptance letter or email** from an accredited law school within the United States as proof of enrollment.
- Proof of legal residency in the U.S. (e.g., **state-issued ID, passport, birth certificate, permanent resident card**, etc.)
- An **email address** that applicants will continue to have access to through late summer, to ensure timely communication regarding scholarship status.

AWARD

After reviewing all applicant submissions, DWC will award scholarship funds as follows:

- A total of **\$10,000** will be awarded to three finalists in the following amounts:
 - 1st Place: \$5,000
 - 2nd Place: \$3,000
 - 3rd Place: \$2,000
- Applicants will be notified of the award selection on or about **August 15, 2027**.
- Scholarships are to be used exclusively for **law school tuition and related expenses**.
- Checks will be made payable **directly to the recipients' law schools**.
- Recipients will be required to submit receipts in accordance with **IRS regulations**.

DEADLINE

Completed applications must be submitted no later than **June 30, 2027**.
